OPENING OF THE SYNOD.

Pope Francis has initiated a world- wide process of listening and discernment. A Synod comes from two Greek words which mean journeying forward together. Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit this will lead to a clearer vision of our faith and what it means to be Church. There will be an opportunity for us to offer our reflections as a Parish under 3 themes communion, participation and mission.

Archbishop John Wilson has written a Pastoral Letter giving an outline of the process. Please take a copy or see on the website.
