LENT 2023

Lent is a special time of preparation for Easter. Lent can be a time for prayerful reflection. It can be a time to live our faith in a new way. Some suggestions:

- [1] set aside a time for prayer each day, it can be 5 minutes. Perhaps use the Sunday or weekday Mass readings to help. A time to be still and place oneself in God's presence;
- [2] attend a weekday Mass in addition to a Sunday Mass;
- [3] pray the Rosary or read a spiritual book by a Saint or Christian writer
- [4] Stations of the Cross on Fridays in Lent at 7.30pm;
- [5] make a visit to the Blessed Sacrament after Sunday mass or before mass on weekdays
- [6] choose a charity to support this Lent as your almsgiving /choose something good to do;
- [7] fast not only from food but from all that does not build God's Kingdom.
- [8] Go to the Sacrament of Reconciliation: experience again the joy of God's forgiveness and mercy.
